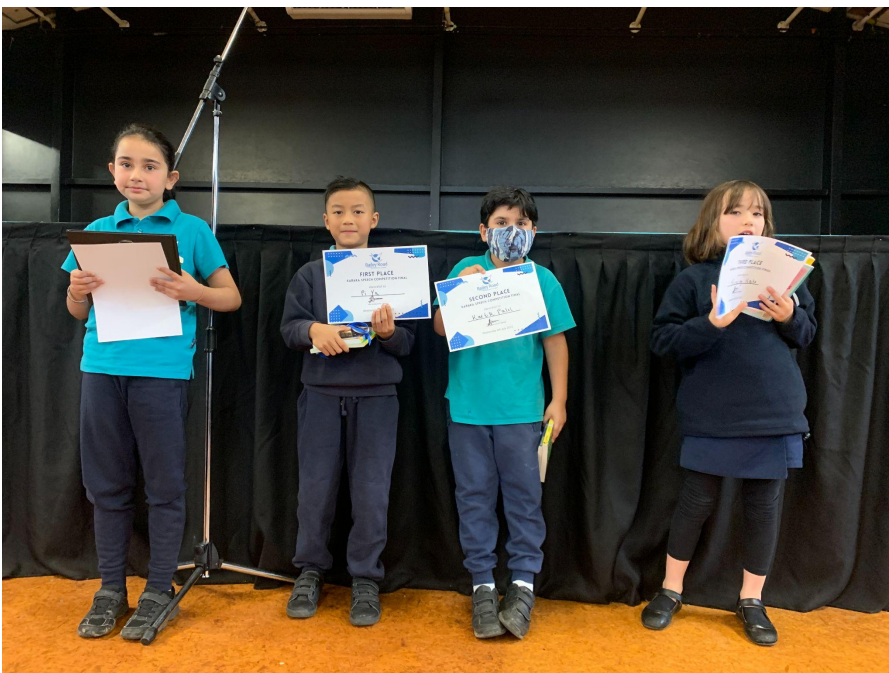

We celebrate Fijian Language week a little before the scheduled time because this language celebration falls during the coming school break. It is wonderful to give our students, with a shared cultural identity, the opportunity to celebrate their awesome heritage with all of the staff, students and community at Bailey Road School.



Our term is coming to an end. This term has, arguably, been the most normal term we have experienced for some time; though we have still been subjected to high levels of absenteeism among our students, as well as a steady, but manageable, covid infection rate with staff [often isolation rather than being ill with covid]. The government has clearly indicated the national concern with attendance and we have been working hard to reduce our student absentee rate.

The reality is, if our students do not come to school they cannot move along the learning pathways we provide with any real hope of being successful as students.

In term three we will maintain all of the Covid restrictions that have kept us remarkably unaffected by the pandemic. Masks will continue to be worn by students in Year 3 and up. Staff will continue to wear masks. Hand sanitiser will be used frequently by all in our school. Large gatherings will be avoided in school except where necessary – and then we will ensure masks are worn and students are distances as much as possible. Parents will not be able to come on site for large school events during this period. We will make every effort to record events like our Speech Finals so that whānau can view and enjoy these activities.

In the next newsletter I will publish our mid year data results. These results are the first we have been able to collect after a relatively uninterrupted period of teaching. We realise there is much work for us still to do together to make up for lost time, but with great attendance and no more lockdowns we will use the experience and skills of our staff to bring our students to the learning places we all wish them to be.

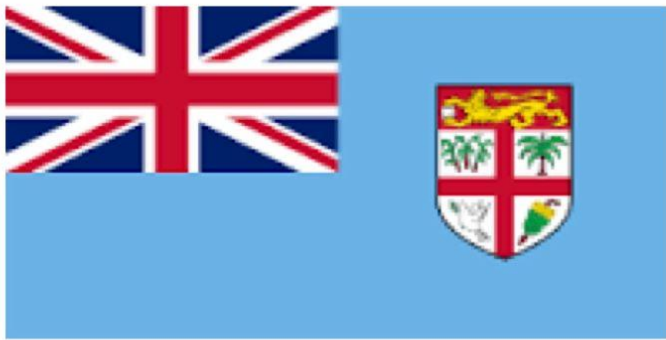
